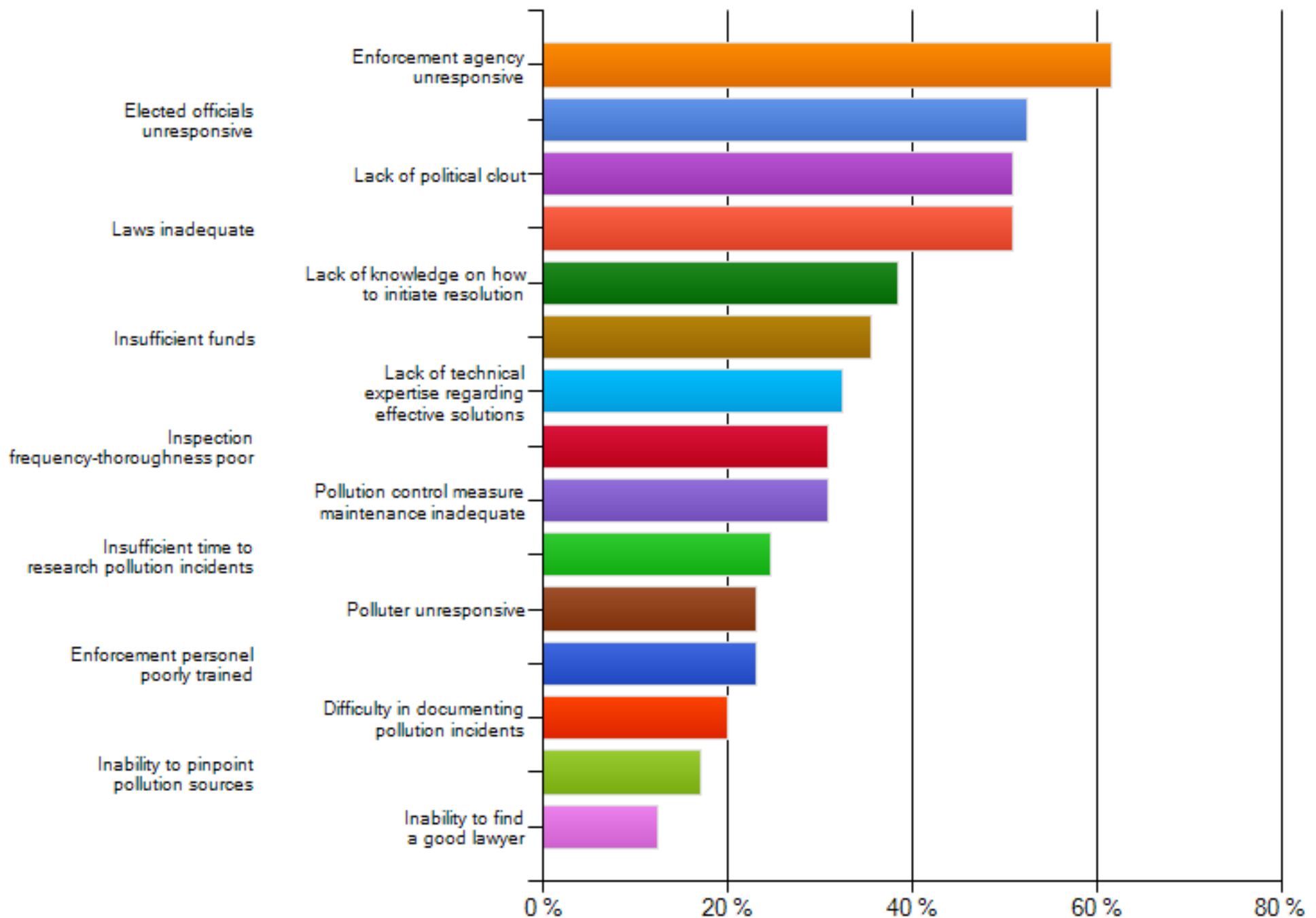


Which of the following has impeded your efforts to resolve water quality threats?

State sanctioned activity of "Beneficial Use Permit" by DEP applied to Municipal Waste Ash concentration of 45.5Tons located along a watershed and over a shallow groundwater table. While Beneficial Use permit was not reinstated, the DEP REFUSES to document a baseline of environmental stats onsite, to determine long-term impacts to watershed.
